

2mm Mini-Shunt Connector

All numerical values are in metric units [with U.S. customary units in brackets]. Dimensions are in millimeters [and inches]. Unless otherwise specified, dimensions have a tolerance of ± 0.13 [± 0.05] and angles have a tolerance of $\pm 2^{\circ}$. Figures and illustrations are for identification only and are not drawn to scale.

1. INTRODUCTION

This specification covers the requirements for application of 2mm Mini-Shunt Connectors. These 2-position connectors are used for mating, commoning, or shorting two 0.5 [.020] square posts on 2.0 [.079] centerlines.

Each connector consists of a glass-filled polyester housing pre-loaded with receptacle contacts of beryllium copper material.



3. REQUIREMENTS

The connectors are used for mating, commoning, or shorting two 0.5 [0.020] square or round posts on 2.0 [.079] centerlines. The post length must be a minimum of 2.54 [.100]. See Figure 2.






FIGURE 3. VISUAL AID
