

Installation Instructions – Application Information


Product Application Guidelines

The bird cap allows its application on different insulator fittings and on bent conductors. If the conductor is fixed aside of the insulator head, a separate piece of conductor has to be fixed to the other side of the insulator and the overhead line.



Dimensional Requirements of Insulator



Dimensional Requirements of Fixing Clamps




Horizontal and Vertical Cap Bending Angles



The length of the Bird Cap is approx. 1,4 m. Check conductor and fixing clamps. If necessary change the fixing clamp position in such a way that they are positioned within the middle part of the cap, see also drawings on previous page.


Conductor only fixed aside:

Install a piece of conductor to the other side of the insulator and fix it with 2 clamps to the main conductor. The distance between the fixing clamps must not exceed 480 mm.




Double insulator configuration:

Change the position of the fixing clamp of the 2^{nd} conductor in such a way that the distance a = min. 800 mm to allow for sufficient free space of the cap.




Insert the cable ties through the integrated clip. Pull the cable tie through both slots so the legs are equal lengths.




Position the cap with one end provisionally over the conductor. Insert the cable tie through the pre-cut holes ensuring it goes under the conductor.

Secure the cable tie within the channel but do not fully tighten.




Move the cap along the conductor and fix the other end to the opposite side of the insulator as shown in drawing **4**.

Secure the cable tie within the channel but do not fully tighten.




Locate the pre-installed cable tie ends so they over hang either side of the conductor.

With the cap in place secure the cable ties and tighten.



Tighten all the cable ties at the ends and cut off the excess length.

Only tighten the hose clamps until the cap is well secured and doesn't move.



Installation of bird cap completed.
