UNDERSTANDING YOUR TERMINATION SOLUTION OPTIONS

Selecting the right terminator platform for your wire harness needs starts with understanding how much force you require to crimp. Small wire sizes require less crimp force, but benefit largely from wire guides, and crimp quality monitoring to help maintain proper termination.

Conversely, larger wire sizes require more crimp force and in some cases the need to process loose-piece terminals.



AMP 5K/40 terminators use a DC motor with gearbox drive. The result is a small-footprint design that is fast and quiet. Cycle time is less than 0.4 seconds with an operation sound level of 76 dB(A).

The GII is one of the quietest terminators on the market. It features improved access to, and significantly updated lighting in the under cabinet and target areas, and includes a variable speed option which gives the operator more flexibility for those tricky applications that benefit from slower ram and feed speeds. And, with its tool-less changeover capability, setup is both quick and easy.

Precision Matters

All GII terminators include precision adjustment for crimp height — an important feature, which, in combination with the optional Crimp Quality Monitor (CQM II), enables repeatable, tight crimp tolerances required for today's demands for higher levels of quality. By simply resetting a dial, the operator can adjust crimp height in 0.013 mm [.0005"] increments over a 0.457 mm [.018"] range.

Complete Control

Our user-friendly LCD control panel includes simple buttons for: adjusting ram speed, jogging the motor forward or reverse, split-cycle operation, work lighting, air feed, and batch counter reset. For improved quality, the controls also detect and report errors in the machine and stop cycling when a bad crimp is detected by the CQM II.

Engineered for High Voltage Applications

The HF-20T and HV-20T are robust, compact, high force bench top machines capable of terminating cables up to 120 mm². Both models are eccentric presses capable of reaching 178 kN (20 tons) of crimp force, with fast, repeatable accuracy. The HV-20 model comes with a CQM II digital interface for crimp force monitoring, variable speed and an integrated vacuum system to keep sensitive connections clean and clear of debris commonly associated with high voltage cable processing.

Flexible Design

To best fit the application process, the flexible design of the high force machines accommodate multiple processing orientations. The adjustable die holder platform can be easily rotated to handle processing from the left, front or right side of the unit. Side feed guarding is also available for all models to accommodate both loose piece and reeled terminal applications.

Safe, Easy Operation

Both models offer a simple push button design with multiple interlock features to confirm operator safety throughout the crimping process.



The HV-20T and HF-20T bench top terminators combine sophisticated controls, a traceability system and multiple ethernet and USB ports to make them Industry 4.0. ready.

Multiple Versions Available

TE standard splice terminators are offered in multiple versions, for both pigtail or thru-splices (with front and rear operator access), and can come with or without crimp quality monitoring (CQM II). When equipped with the CQM II, force and position can be measured during every crimp cycle, providing real-time monitoring of crimp height, the fundamental crimp characteristic, and the shape of the work curve for every termination. Standard Splice terminators do not accept heavy-duty mini (HDM), heavy-duty industrial (HDI) and OCEAN applicators.

If better access to present wires to the crimping area is needed, the Inverted Splice Terminator (IST) provides more flexibility when terminating leads from completed motor assemblies. When using the pig-tail applicator, operators can cut excess wire using the integrated shear in the applicator, thereby keeping leads as small as possible (short break out). Shorter leads provide added flexibility to post-process magnet wire applications. Operators can more easily tuck in or heat shrink terminated lead ends, allowing for potentially smaller motor housings.







TERMINATOR OPTIONS

Crimp Height Adjustment Using Precision Adjustment Mechanism



- Uses detent stops in the mechanism to adjust crimp height
- Indexing the mechanism can be done in either direction
- Allows users to change the crimp height in increments of approx. 0.013 mm [.0005 in.] per step

Control Panels

Decrease Speed

Decreases the motor speed for normal cycle operation and for jogging.

Increase Speed

Increases the motor speed for normal cycle operation and for jogging.

Error Reset

Clears the displayed error code.

Count Reset

Clears the batch count to 0.

Jog & Jog Reverse

Causes the DC motor to rotate forward or backward at the jog speed set by the increase/decrease speed. Reverse is only available on GII & GII+ models.

Full Cycle

Terminator rotates one full cycle when the footswitch is pressed. The LED light will remain on when in this mode of operation. GII & GII+ models only.

Split Cycle

The terminator rotates to the down position on the first press of the footswitch, then completes the cycle on the second press of the footswitch. The LED light will remain on when in this mode of operation. GII & GII+ models only.

Split cycle is required for some closed barrel terminals and data connectivity applications.

TERMINATOR OPTIONS

Crimp Quality Monitor (CQM II)

When used on TE terminators the CQM II provides a complete crimp detection analysis. It checks every crimp as it is produced, measuring crimp height of each termination and evaluating the quality of each crimp. If a crimp has questionable characteristics, visual and audible alarms alert the operator. The CQM II includes data ports for printing and networking.

CQM II offers five different crimp analysis methods.

- Crimp height
- Work index
- Peak force
- Fast Fourier Transform (FFT)
- Point-to-point


